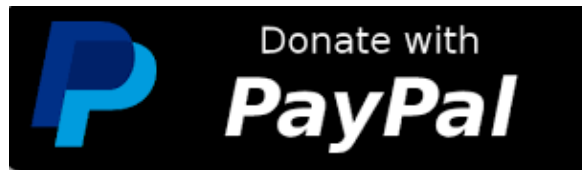

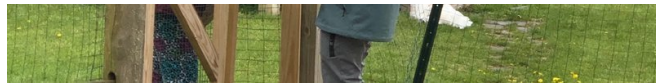
## **Community Care - Call to Action**

### **Support an Emergency Food Crisis Hotline in Suffolk County!**

In the midst of the COVID-19 crisis, many Long Island families do not have reliable access to



food.



Every community in Suffolk County has been affected by the COVID-19 public health emergency. Indigenous, African American, Latino, immigrant, low and fixed income, undocumented, and elderly communities, among others, are facing particular hardship because of already existing vulnerabilities in our nation's social services, labor, and health systems. Some in our communities are living with only one to two days of food supply. Others may have the means to purchase, but due to age, health status, pregnancy, transportation difficulties, distance from stocked supermarkets, federal restrictions on using SNAP benefits for delivery costs, disability, and/or other factors are unable to access food.

**Sign This Petition** to call for the implementation of an integrated county-wide emergency food crisis hotline that will provide, if necessary, rapid food delivery to any and all homebound Suffolk County families and individuals experiencing urgent food crisis.
